The Fight/War Started in Heaven

<u>Genesis 3:4</u> Wherefore, because that Satan rebelled against me, and sought to destroy the agency of man, which I, the Lord God, had given him; and also that I should give unto him mine own power; by the power of mine Only Begotten I caused that he should be cast down; and he became Satan.

Isaiah 14:12-16

- 12 How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!
- 13 For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north;
- 14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the Most High.
- 15 Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.
- 16 They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and shall consider thee, and shall say, Is this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms?

<u>Revelation 12:6</u> And there was war in heaven; Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought against Michael.

<u>Revelation 12:4</u> And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman which was delivered, ready to devour her child after it was born.



Revelation 12:8 Neither was there place found in heaven for the great dragon, who was cast out; that old serpent called the devil, and also called Satan, which deceiveth the whole world; he was cast out into the earth; and his angels were cast out with him.

Genesis 3:1-5

1 And I, the Lord God, spake unto Moses, saying, That Satan whom thou hast commanded in the name of mine Only Begotten, is the same which was from the beginning;

2 And he came before me, saying, Behold I, send me, I will be thy Son, and I will redeem all mankind, that one soul shall not be lost, and surely I will do it; wherefore, give me thine honor.

3 But behold, my beloved Son, which was my beloved and chosen from the beginning, said unto me: Father, thy will be done, and the glory be thine forever.

4 Wherefore, because that Satan rebelled against me, and sought to destroy the agency of man, which I, the Lord God, had given him; and also that I should give unto him mine own power; by the power of mine Only Begotten I caused that he should be cast down; and he became Satan. 5 Yea, even the devil, the father of all lies, to deceive, and to blind men, and to lead them captive at his will, even as many as would not hearken unto my voice.

We Were There at the Foundation of the World

<u>Alma 9:65-68</u> 65 And this is the manner after which they were ordained: <u>being called and</u> <u>prepared from the foundation of the world, according to the foreknowledge of God,</u> on account of their exceeding faith and good works; in the first place being left to choose good or evil;

66 Therefore they having chosen good, and exercising exceeding great faith, are called with a holy calling, yea, with that holy calling which was prepared with, and according to, a preparatory redemption for such;

67 And thus they have been called to this holy calling on account of their faith, while others would reject the Spirit of God on account of the hardness of their hearts and blindness of their minds, while, if it had not been for this, they might have had as great privilege as their brethren. 68 Or in fine: in the first place they were on the same standing with their brethren; thus this holy calling being prepared from the foundation of the world for such as would not harden their hearts, being in and through the atonement of the only begotten Son, who was prepared.

We Need Not Fear Satan Because Jesus Has All Power

<u>Mosiah 1:102</u> And he shall be called Jesus Christ, the Son of God, the Father of heaven and earth, the Creator of all things, from the beginning.

Matthew 28:17 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

Satan is Busy and Active = The Battle, The Fight is On Going = A Daily Battle

- <u>Luke 22:</u>31 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold Satan hath desired you, that he may sift the children of the kingdom as wheat.
- 32 But I have prayed for you, that your faith fail not; and when you are converted strengthen your brethren.
- Sec. 52:3d And let my servant Lyman Wight beware, for Satan desireth to sift him as chaff.



<u>1 Nephi 4:52</u> For the day should come that they must be judged of their works, yea, even the works which were done by the temporal body in their days of probation.

<u>Alma 9:41</u> Therefore this life became a probationary state; a time to prepare to meet God; a time to prepare for that endless state, which has been spoken of by us, which is after the resurrection of the dead.

<u>Alma 19:84</u> And thus we see, that there was a time granted unto man, to repent, yea, a probationary time, a time to repent and serve God.

2 Nephi 6:56 But wo unto him that has the law given; yea, that has all the commandments of God, like unto us, and that transgresseth them, and that wasteth the days of his probation; for awful is his state!

<u>Philippians 4:8</u> Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just; whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.

Crown of Glory

- I Peter 5:2 Feed (give food to teach)
- the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;
 - 3 Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being ensamples to the flock.
- 4 And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.



Run a Good Race, Fight a Good Fight and Get the Incorruptible Crown

- 1 Corinthians 9
 24 Know ye not that they which run in a race all run, but only one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain.
- 25 And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate (to exercise self-control or restraint & be chaste) in all things.
- Now they do it to obtain a
- corruptible crown;
- but we an incorruptible.
 - 26 I therefore so run, not as
- uncertainly; so fight I,
- not as one
- that beateth the air;
- 27 But I keep under my body,
- and bring it into subjection;



Crown of Rejoicing

1 Thessalonians 2:19 For what is our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? Are not even ye in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at his coming?

20 For ye are our glory and joy.

This is often called the soul winner's crown, for those who win souls to Christ

Crown of Life

- James 1:11 For the sun is no sooner risen with a burning heat, but it withereth the grass, and the flower thereof falleth, and the grace of the fashion of it perisheth; so also shall the rich man fade away in his ways.
 - 12 Blessed is the man that resisteth temptation; for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them
- that love him.

Revelation 2:10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer; behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days; be thou faithful unto death and I will give thee a crown of life.



What Purpose These Crowns

Revelation 4:10-11 The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sits on the throne, and worship him that liveth forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying, 11 Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

The Four and Twenty Elders Cast Their Crowns Before God

- Hopefully we will have opportunity to do the same.
- Pastor Tim Burt: "What made these great men able to be used of God? It was their humble and hungry heart to know and serve God and His plan. Their love and hunger to know, love, and serve God gave them a spiritual perception and eyesight that the rest of the world does not have. It causes you to see God in the details of your life in a way that others can't.
- It causes your faith to become stronger than most because you constantly see God working in your life. And no matter what good comes to you, you know and acknowledge that it is from and because of Him. People with this kind of heart and perception are daily casting their crown at His feet."



Let's Prepare For Eternity


Colossians 3:20 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

Write The Vision

We can never say we did not know these things = God has given us great revelations in our day concerning eternity



- DC 76: 1c his purposes fail not, neither are there any who can stay his hand; from eternity to eternity he is the same, and his years never fail........
- 2a For thus saith the Lord, I, the Lord, am merciful and gracious unto those who fear me, and delight to honor those who serve me in righteousness and in truth unto the end;
- 2b great shall be their reward, and eternal shall be their glory;

Celestial Glory

D&C 76:5a-5r

5a And again, we bear record for we saw and heard, and this is the testimony of the gospel of Christ, concerning them who come forth in the resurrection of the just:

5b They are they who received the testimony of Jesus, and believed on his name, and were baptized after the manner of his burial, being buried in the water in his name, and this according to the commandment which he has given, that by keeping the commandments, they might be washed and cleansed from all their sins,

5c and receive the Holy Spirit by the laying on of the hands of him who is ordained and sealed unto this power;

5d and who overcome by faith, and are sealed by that Holy Spirit of promise, which the Father sheds forth upon all those who are just and true;

5e they are they who are the church of the Firstborn;

5f they are they into whose hands the Father has given all things:

5g they are they who are priests and kings, who have received of his fullness, and of his glory, and are priests of the Most High after the order of Melchisedec, which was after the order of Enoch, which was after the order of the only begotten Son:

5h wherefore, as it is written, they are gods, even the sons of God; wherefore all things are theirs, whether life or death, or things present, or things to come, all are theirs, and they are Christ's, and Christ is God's; and they shall overcome all things;

5i wherefore let no man glory in man, but rather let him glory in God, who shall subdue all enemies under his feet;

5j these shall dwell in the presence of God and his Christ for ever and ever:

5k these are they whom he shall bring with him, when he shall come in the clouds of heaven, to reign on the earth over his people;

5I these are they who shall have part in the first resurrection;

5m these are they who shall come forth in the resurrection of the just;

5n these are they who are come unto Mount Zion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly place, the holiest of all;

50 these are they who have come to an innumerable company of angels; to the general assembly and church of Enoch, and of the Firstborn;

5p these are they whose names are written in heaven, where God and Christ are the judge of all;

5q these are they who are just men made perfect through Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, who wrought out this perfect atonement through the shedding of his own blood;

5r these are they whose bodies are celestial, whose glory is that of the sun, even the glory of God the highest of all; whose glory the sun of the firmament is written of as being typical.

Terrestrial Glory

D&C 76:6a-6h

6a And again, we saw the terrestrial world, and, behold, and lo;

6b these are they who are of the terrestrial, whose glory differs from that of the church of the Firstborn, who have received the fullness of the Father, even as that of the moon differs from the sun of the firmament.

6c Behold, these are they who died without law; and also they who are the spirits of men kept in prison, whom the Son visited, and preached the gospel unto them, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, who received not the testimony of Jesus in the flesh, but afterwards received it;

6d these are they who are honorable men of the earth, who were blinded by the craftiness of men:

6e these are they who receive of his glory, but not of his fullness;

6f these are they who receive of the presence of the Son, but not of the fullness of the Father; wherefore they are bodies terrestrial, and not bodies celestial, and differ in glory as the moon differs from the sun;

6g these are they who are not valiant in the testimony of Jesus; wherefore they obtained not the crown over the kingdom of our God.

6h And now this is the end of the vision which we saw of the terrestrial, that the Lord commanded us to write while we were yet in the Spirit.

Telestial Glory

D&C 76:7a-7f

7a And again, we saw the glory of the telestial, which glory is that of the lesser, even as the glory of the stars differs from that of the glory of the moon in the firmament;

7b these are they who received not the gospel of Christ, neither the testimony of Jesus;

7c these are they who deny not the Holy Spirit;

7d these are they who are thrust down to hell;

7e these are they who shall not be redeemed from the Devil, until the last resurrection, until the Lord, even Christ the Lamb, shall have finished his work;

7f these are they who receive not of his fullness in the eternal world, but of the Holy Spirit through the ministration of the terrestrial; and the terrestrial through the ministration of the celestial: and also the telestial receive it of the administering of angels, who are appointed to minister for them, or who are appointed to be ministering spirits for them, for they shall be heirs of salvation.

Continued Description of the Glories

D&C 76:7g-7m

7g And thus we saw in the heavenly vision, the glory of the telestial which surpasses all understanding; and no man knows it except him to whom God has revealed it.

7h And thus we saw the glory of the terrestrial, which excels in all things the glory of the telestial, even in glory, and in power, and in might, and in dominion.

7i And thus we saw the glory of the celestial, which excels in all things; where God, even the Father, reigns upon his throne for ever and ever, before whose throne all things bow in humble reverence and give him glory for ever and ever.

7j They who dwell in his presence are the church of the Firstborn; and they see as they are seen, and know as they are known, having received of his fullness and of his grace; and he makes them equal in power, and in might, and in dominion.

7k And the glory of the celestial is one, even as the glory of the sun is one. And the glory of the terrestrial is one, even as the glory of the moon is one.

7l And the glory of the telestial is one, even as the glory of the stars is one, for as one star differs from another star in glory, even so differs one from another in glory in the telestial world; for these are they who are of Paul, and of Apollos, and of Cephas;

7m these are they who say they are some of one and some of another, some of Christ, and some of John, and some of Moses, and some of Elias; and some of Esais, and some of Isaiah, and some of Enoch, but received not the gospel, neither the testimony of Jesus, neither the prophets; neither the everlasting covenant;

No Glory Level

D&C 76:7n-7s

7n Last of all, these all are they who will not be gathered with the saints, to be caught up unto the church of the Firstborn, and received into the cloud;

70 these are they who are liars, and sorcerers, and adulterers, and whoremongers, and whosoever loves and makes a lie;

7p these are they who suffer the wrath of God on the earth;

7q these are they who suffer the vengeance of eternal fire;

7r these are they who are cast down to hell and suffer the wrath of Almighty God until the fullness of times, when Christ shall have subdued all enemies under his feet, and shall have perfected his work, when he shall deliver up the kingdom and present it unto the Father spotless, saying:

7s I have overcome and have trodden the wine press alone, even the wine press of the fierceness of the wrath of Almighty God; then shall he be crowned with the crown of his glory, to sit on the throne of his power to reign for ever and ever.

Final Statement

D&C 76:7t-7w

7t But, behold, and lo, we saw the glory and the inhabitants of the telestial world, that they were as innumerable as the stars in the firmament of heaven, or as the sand upon the seashore, and heard the voice of the Lord saying:

7u These all shall bow the knee, and every tongue shall confess to him who sits upon the throne for ever and ever;

7v for they shall be judged according to their works; and every man shall receive according to his own works, and his own dominion, in the mansions which are prepared, and they shall be servants of the Most High, but where God and Christ dwell they cannot come, worlds without end.

7w This is the end of the vision which we saw, which we were commanded to write while we were yet in the Spirit.
